He was **line producer** of films like "BOSSA NOVA", with Amy Irving, and "SEVEN DAYS IN SEPTEMBER", with Alan Arkin, Oscar indicated for Best Foreign Film in 2000, both of Bruno Barreto. In 2001 Tuinho founded **FOCUS ENTRETENIMENTO**, which rendered services to **production companies** such as Ridley Scott Associates (US and UK), Believemedia and Villains (US), Bikini Films (UK), Mandarin Cinema and the traditional Pathé Films (FR); **TV enterprises** such as BBC, ABC TV, France 2, France 3 and Endemol (BR, FR and IT); and **international advertising agencies** such as AMV BBDO, BBH, Deutsch, Dorland, Hakuhodo, J.W.Thompson, Leo Burnett, McCann Erickson, Ogilvy, Saatchi & Saatchi and Wieden & Kennedy.
